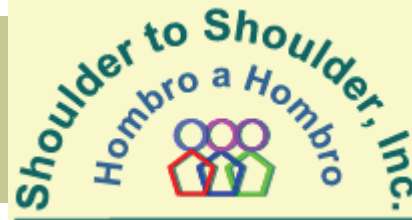

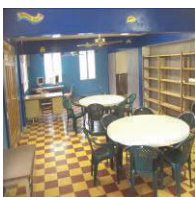


The O'Dea Family

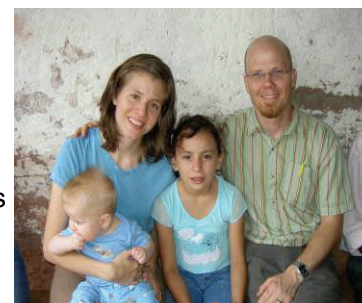
